Tumaini Timbwanu School

The school was our first project, which now employs 78 local people and educates 650 children from 3 - 18 years old. Everyone has to pay something towards their education but poverty means this is a struggle for many families. We run a programme to allow people like you to give more children the opportunity of an education by sponsoring them.



Feeding programme

Every day the 'mamas' of Education for Life cook a meal for upwards of 650 children and staff from Tumaini Timbwanu School and children from the local community who are not at school yet. They also provide porridge for children who don't get breakfast at home.

Fresh water project

There's no piped water supply in the neighbourhood, so Education for Life has helped local people set up a business to supply affordable clean water to the local community.



A special place for special children

We offer a supportive environment for children with special needs and their families. A place they can explore practical skills, one-to-one learning and regular exercise.



Tumaini family church

Our church is a place where local people can come together for singing and prayers – helping to create a sense of community. Many children attend the church and Sunday School because it's safe, it's fun and they can explore life together.



Children's home

We originally set out to build a home for a few children in serious need of support, but before the building was complete the number had already grown to 19! Today the home is run by local couple Charles and Mary who are the foster parents to over 20 children. With your help these children are attending Timbwanu school.



Zaidi share a cow project

Zaidi is a sustainable project providing farmers in Taita Hills with a helping hand to start a business. We provide the farmer with a good milking cow, he then sells the milk to generate an income, enabling him to clothe, feed and educate his family and repay the cost of the cow, which buys a cow for another farmer.



Our other projects include: 'Mama Sema' our regular womens' support and bible study group, our Forest Adventure and Environmental School allowing our students to learn about the forest, animals, farming techniques, and environmental issues, and 'Mi pad' that provides affordable feminine hygiene products so girls don't have to miss school for a week every month. We continue to look for long-term solutions to the challenges people face in Likoni and Taita Hills.
